## 2008 Convention Notes

Welcome to the 2008 USHA Annual Convention. This year we have another great program, with four out of state speakers, along with USU faculty and NRCS staff. We encourage you to read the following notes and **changes** about this year's Convention.

**Date and Location:** The convention will be held at the Health/Justice Center at 151 South University Ave. in Provo, in rooms 1600-1601. The winter tour is Jan. 21, and the program Jan. 22-23, 2008.

**Program:** This year both the Tuesday and Wednesday morning sessions will begin at 8:30 AM instead of 9:00 AM. Lunch will be provided on Tuesday Jan. 22. For those interested, the Utah Berry Growers Association Annual Meeting will be held in the same location on Wednesday Jan. 23, from 1-5 PM.

**Membership:** Membership fee is \$30.00 when you register prior to the convention, and \$40 at the door. This fee covers attending the winter tour on Monday, the annual convention, and lunch on Tuesday. **Orchard Tour.** The winter tour will be held Monday Jan. 21 with tours, demonstrations and a good lunch. The tour bus will depart Monday Morning from the LDS meetinghouse at 100 S. 200 E. in Santaquin at 8:30 AM.
