For retail sale to and use only by Certified Applicators or persons under their direct supervision and only for those uses covered by the Certified Applicator's certification. Commercial certified applicators must also ensure that all persons involved in these activities are informed of the precautionary statements.

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

1. Date of application

- Month

- day

- year

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

2. Brand or Product Name

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

3. EPA Registration Number

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

4. Amount of pesticide applied

- Record the total amount of the product used
- **Not** the application rate

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

5. Size of area treated

- Record this information in the unit of measure which is shown on the label

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

6. Location of the pesticide application

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

7. Name of certified applicator

8. Certification number

Note: If you keep your records all in one place,
you only have to record steps 7 and 8 once

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

Spot Applications

- Small applications which total less than 1/10th of an acre
- Spot applications are not allowed for Recordkeeping requirements at nurseries or greenhouses

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

Spot Application Requirements

1. Date of application - month, day, year
2. Brand or product name
3. EPA registration number
4. Total amount of pesticide applied
5. Location of the pesticide application, designated as “spot application” & a short description

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

Pesticide application must be recorded **within 14 days** of application

Pesticide Recordkeeping Requirements

The law requires that pesticide records be maintained for a minimum of **two years from the date of application**

COMMON MISTAKES

- Missing EPA Registration Number
- Using Rate of Application (vs. Total Amount Applied)
- Missing Name and License Number
