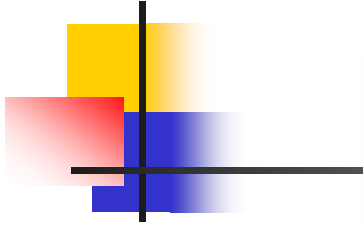
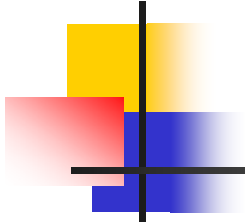

Organic System Plan (OSP)



- § 205.201 Organic production and handling system plan must:
 1. description of practices and procedures to be performed and maintained, including frequency
 2. Describe each substance to be used as a production and handling input, composition, source, locations used, commercial availability
 3. Describe monitoring practices, procedures, frequency performed and effectiveness
 4. description of record keeping system
 5. Describe plan for prevention of commingling of organic, non –organic and prohibited substances



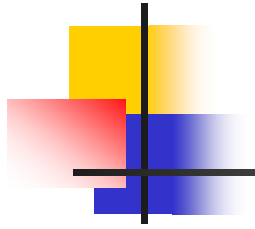
§ 205.202 Land Requirements

- no prohibited substances for 3 years
Field history sheets
- defined adequate boundaries and buffer zones
maps, charts

205.203 Soil fertility and crop nutrient management:

- implement, tillage and cultivation practices that maintain or improve physical, chemical and biological condition of the soil and minimize soil erosion
- manage crop nutrients and soil fertility through rotations, cover crops and application of plant and animal materials
- manage plant and animal materials to maintain or improve soil organic matter...not contaminate crops soil or water
- must not use synthetic substances, sewage sludge or burning to dispose of crop residues

205.204 seeds and planting stock:



- must use organically grown seeds, annual seedlings and planting stock



COMMERCIAL AVAILABILITY

- Inspectors will Check/Audit
 1. SUPPLIERS POLLED FOR AVAILABILITY
 2. WIDELY KNOWN SOURCES FOR MATERIALS
 3. COMPARE SPECIES OF PRODUCTS FOUND TO BE UNAVAILABLE WITH NON-CERTIFIED INPUTS USED.

- **COST IS NOT A FACTOR**



§ 205.205 Crop rotation standard:

- crop rotation, not limited to sod, cover crops, green manure, catch crops
- maintain or improve soil organic content
- Provide pest management
- manage deficient or excess plant nutrients
- provide erosion control



§ 205.206 Crop pest, weed and disease management:

- method to prevent crop pests
- method to prevent weeds
- methods to suppress or prevent diseases



§205.103 Record keeping by certified operations:

- adapted to particular business
- fully disclose all transactions and activities
- maintained 5 years
- easy to audit and understand
- compliance to regulations
- records available for inspection
